As you can see from the chart below, a cow produces her maximum amount of milk 30-90 days after her calf is born. It's all downhill from there, until we stop milking her entirely for 2 months before the birth of her next calf.

At the moment, we have enough milk for our regular customers, but not enough to take on new folks. Check back with us next summer, to find out when the 2008 calves will be born.
